

Dear Prospective Gordon Adopter,

Thanks for your interest in Gordon Setter Rescue. Those of us working with rescue feel strongly that all Gordons deserve a wonderful home. The North Country Gordon Setter club volunteers work hard to try and find the best possible home for each and every Gordon in the rescue program.

The following 'application' is used to find the best possible match for each particular dog. Every dog is different, and each home is different. It is important you fill out the information as accurately as possible. Do not try and guess what the correct answers are. There are no right or wrong answers. It is entirely possible we could have more than one dog in the program, and both of them would match your home situation, the application will help us find the best match. It is also possible neither would fit your home situation. This does not mean you are not an approved home, it just means we don't have a dog that *fits* your home *at this time*. Your application will stay on file for future reference. For example, if you say you do not have a fenced yard, it doesn't mean you will not get a dog, it is possible we could get a dog that climbs fences, which means fences don't make a difference. If you say you have cats, and the dog we are looking at placing hates cats, it probably would not be the best home for that particular dog. Every situation is different, so we need to gather as much information as possible. We will not consider you are truly interested in a dog until we get the application back with the information completed.

Once the application is received, please do not feel as though you will never get a dog from us if we don't call back right away. Feel free to follow up with a phone call to make sure it was received. We will keep your application on file until we think we have a dog that fits your home situation. At that time we will follow up with a phone call to see if you are still interested or for any clarifications on your application. The nature of the program is it could be days, weeks, or months before we have the right dog for you. It all depends on how many dogs in the program, and their background. We hope if you are truly interested in a Gordon, you will be patient and wait, but we realize a lot can happen over time, and it is possible you might have found another dog in the meantime. If so, just let us know when we call.
